EXCLUSIVE OR COMMON HOLD

You can place an external call via TL or ATL on exclusive or common hold; these features enable the user to set up other calls, answer calls without having to transfer the call on hold immediately.

A call placed on exclusive hold can only be retrieved by the user who carried out the hold; a call placed on common hold can be retrieved by any extension of the installation.
