Your telephone comprises three keys pre-programmed as forward, call-back and last number keys.



These three keys can be re-programmed as:

- a one touch external number,
- a function or an internal number
- recall
- tone recovery

The Line / Rel key is used to dial without lifting the handset and to end a call or leave programming mode.






