

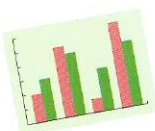

Telecommunications are a key factor in efficiency and development, but also a major item of expenditure which cannot always be easily kept under control.

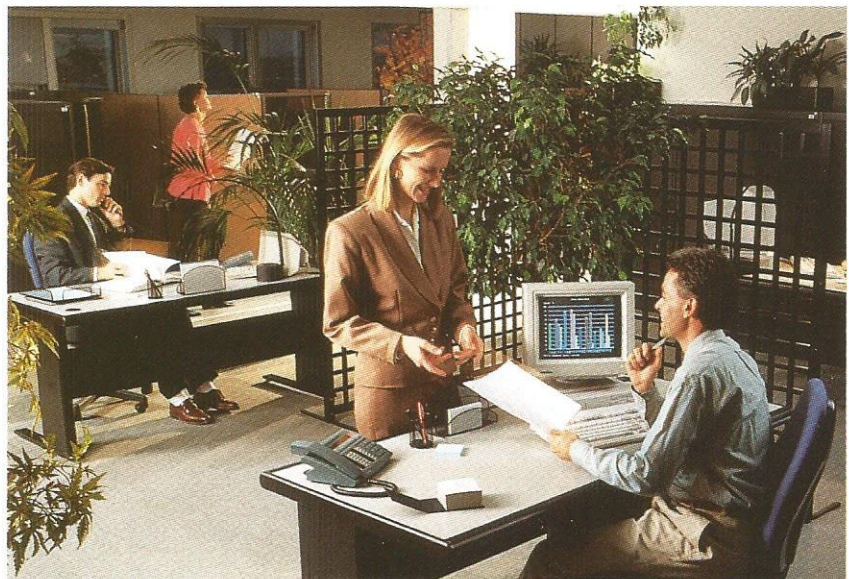

The ready-to-use analysis reports process and present the information according to various criteria: cost and duration of calls per set, per direction called, etc...

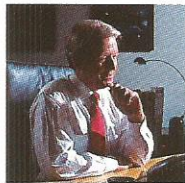


Software integrated in company tools

You are keen to cut your overheads. The telecom

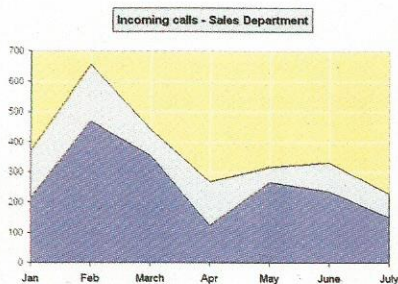

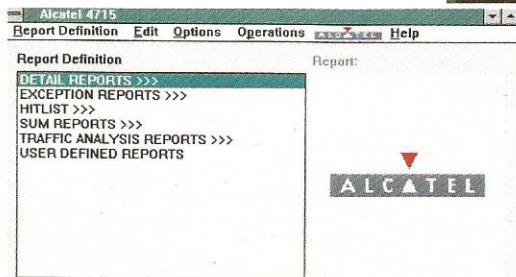

Alcatel 4715 AX: a novel solution

The Alcatel 4715 AX consists of a processing module and software allowing database management and creation of analysis reports.



Non-dedicated

Conventional charging systems require the PC to be dedicated to this application.

The Alcatel 4715 AX does away with this constraint.

The processing module is equipped with its own processor, its own memory (RAM) and a backup battery. Your PC thus retains all its characteristics for your standard applications, without any disturbance. You can switch your PC on or off normally.



Transparent in use

The Alcatel 4715 AX processing module is integrated in your PC at a standard location. On each telephone call, the PBX sends the processing module a ticket which it analyses and stores in its internal memory. Every day, the tickets are transferred automatically by a protected procedure to the Alcatel 4715 AX software database. All these operations are transparent in standard use of your PC.

Protected under all circumstances

With your PBX operating 24 hours a day, even if your PC is off, the processing module will be able to use its backup battery to continue to receive the tickets and store them. It is also equipped with an alarm which informs you when the link with your PBX is broken.

Every day the module switches on your PC for the time required for transferring the data to the hard disk.

Every morning, the data is available to be consulted.

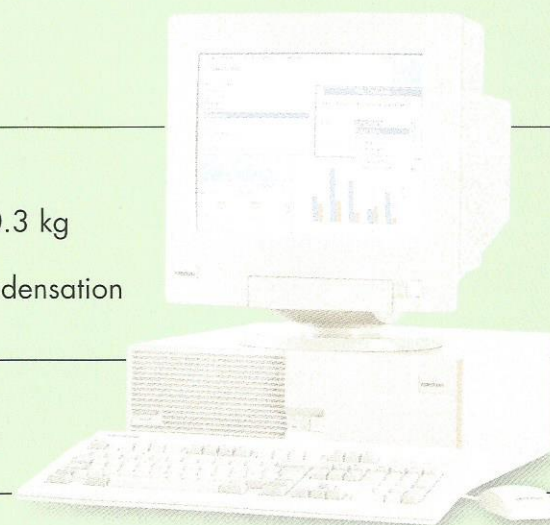
